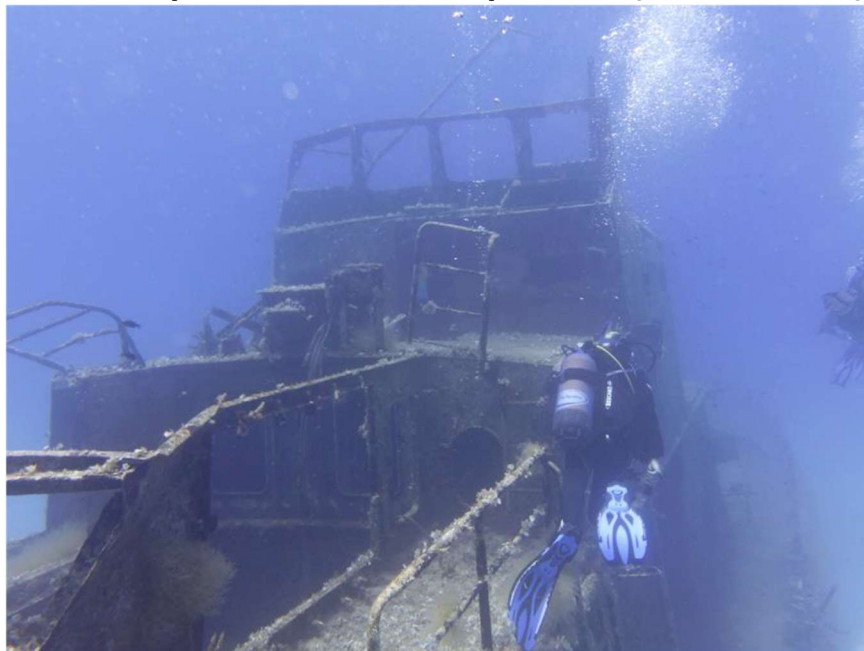

During the programme, participants will be given the opportunity with Dive Systems Malta, to complete a beginners diving course having the chance to dive and explore fascinating historic wrecks dating to WW2.
